RESTORING SAFE SERVICES: PHASE FOUR RE: FACE COVERINGS

Effective August 7th, 2020 at Canad Inns Destination Centre Brandon, and Monday August 17th at all other Manitoba Destination Centres, all persons entering a Canad Inns Destination Centre are asked to wear a Face Covering when in public areas, and/or anytime a minimum of 2m physical distance cannot be reasonably maintained.

As Essential Service Providers, employees of Hotels and Hospitality Services have been on the frontline since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic. One of our guiding priorities will always be to safeguard the wellbeing of our employees, and our customers.

As Hoteliers, we are often one of the first stops for people arriving from out of province, and believe the request for all persons to cover their faces while in public areas is a reasonable accommodation to help minimize the risks to those essential frontline workers, and the citizens they serve.

PROTOCOLS & PRACTICES

- All persons are asked to wear a Face Covering (i.e. face mask, face shield, or other) covering the nose and mouth while in public areas of our facilities.
- All persons are required to adhere to proper Personal Protective Equipment Use Guidelines as per Manitoba Shared Health
- Face Coverings must be appropriate for an all-ages environment (i.e. no scary, vulgar, or obscene imagery)
- Face Coverings are NOT required in the following circumstances:
 - Once seated in a Restaurant, Lounge, Meeting Room or other Food Service Venue, and a 2m distance can be reasonably maintained, or a physical divider is in place
 - Within Hotel Guest Rooms
 - Within Splasher's Pool & Waterslide Facilities
 - Within Fitness Rooms
 - Young children who do not have any COVID-19 symptoms or risk factors
 - Adults who cannot wear a Face Covering for Medical Reasons and who do not have any COVID-19 symptoms or risk factors

Whenever possible, persons who are unable to wear a face covering for medical reason are asked to contact the General Manager in advance

Due to ongoing supply shortages, all persons are asked to supply their own masks when possible. Disposable masks will be provided upon request for a suggested donation of \$1 to the Canad Inns Foundation.

We would like to thank the hardworking men and women who continue to provide valuable essential services during this difficult time, and we thank all our customers for their invaluable support.
